#### **BACKGROUND**

The Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) have been established by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) to help in accelerating the agricultural production and improving the socioeconomic conditions of the farming community. There are around 693 KVKs in India functioning under the control of State Agricultural Universities (SAUs), ICAR Institutes, Central Agricultural Universities (CAUs), Central Universities (CUs), Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs). Administrative control over the staff employed under the KVK is vested in the host institutions because the scientific, technical, and administrative personnel working at the KVKs are members of the respective host institution's cadre and their service conditions are governed by the host institution's personal policies and statutes.

The KVK rely on their scientists, technical and administrative personnel to carry out technological testing and improvement programs, front-line demonstrations, in-service training for the field level extension functionaries and training for farmers, farm women and rural youth. Cutting-edge institutes like KVKs require knowledgeable, committed and creative personnel because of its unique characteristics and flexibility, which enable different staff members to take on different responsibilities depending on local needs and circumstances.

The intended capacity building program has been carefully designed to assist the KVK functionaries in carrying out their duties and responsibilities while handling day-to-day activities related to procurement, PFMS/TSA, budgeting, accounting, inventory management etc. The targeted capacity building program's goal is not to change the service conditions of the personnel of the KVKs but to improve the knowledge and skills of the individual in order to enhance the organizational efficiency.
